Please send only "play clothes"!

DO NOT BRING: (volunteers too!)

- Expensive Toys or Games (Game Boys)
- Water/Squirt Guns

OPTIONAL:

- Sports Equipment-Baseball Gloves, Footballs, etc.

****Swimsuits-** We ask all female campers and volunteers to wear a proper fitting one piece bathing suit or tankini bathing suit- one that covers the top and bottom portion adequately. Camp Smile-A-Mile is a children's camp and even though we understand there are some females that have 'developed' more than others, we ask that you as the parent being mindful of what type bathing suit your daughter is wearing and advise accordingly. If your daughter's suit is improper for camp, then they will be asked to swim in a t-shirt and shorts.

PARENTS & VOLUNTEERS, BE SURE TO WRITE OWNER'S NAME ON EVERY PIECE OF CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT! PLEASE USE A PERMANENT OR FABRIC MARKER. EVERYTHING MIGHT NOT COME BACK CLEAN BUT EVERYTHING MIGHT COME BACK!

We strongly encourage parents to check their camper's luggage and the lost and found before leaving camp. It will be much easier to locate lost items at that time. Two weeks after camp, all lost and found items will be donated to a local charity, if not retrieved by the rightful owner.
